

Required Information for a General Education Syllabus

Your syllabus for a General Education course should include the following:

- An explicit label of the General Education attribute(s) attached to the course, (e.g, SIDI, WRCO, etc.)
- The academic catalog description(s) of the Direction or Connection(s) satisfied by the course (can be cut and pasted from the catalog)
- Reflective discussion of how this particular course meets General Education goals (a brief description that is meaningful to students)
- Explicit learning outcomes that pertain to the skills most pertinent to the course (e.g., writing, quantitative reasoning, critical thinking, collaboration, research, working with technology, listening/speaking).
- An explanation of how course activities and assignments are used to assess the skills most central to the course.
